Mobile Art: *I come to you! No need to travel!*

CADETTES & SENIORS

Folk Arts IPP

Girls will make homemade beads, a Michigan folk art piece, design a mask. Girls will use at least two computer programs to find designs to be used in the all natural art of henna and get to try their hand at this traditional temporary body art. The girls will also learn about careers in Curating and Art Conservation.

Just Jewelry IPP

Girls will complete and design a memory wire necklace and bracelet to match, make earrings, decorate a small ring box, make homemade beads and learn about gem stones.

Artistic Crafts IPP

Make 5 projects covering all areas of handbuilt potter including: coil, pinch, slab and combinations. Learn about figurines. Learn about finishing techniques for your fired ceramic pieces. This is NOT a molded ceramic lesson, we will be using both white and terra cotta fired clay to make 5 projects.

Studio 2b Uniquely Me Inside & Out

Learn about the art of henna, henna designs, its history, truths and myths and the proper technique of henna/mendhi. Make a henna stencil and learn to apply henna body art.

Most requirements for the IPP are covered in the workshop, call to find out which requirements you will have to do on your own. If a troop desires they can choose to use the "Learn, Share, Do" option for earning the IPP in the workshop - please ask for this option and we will design the workshop to use this method.

TIME

All requirements for the above IPP's will be covered in the approximately 1 1/2 hour – 2 hour session at your location. All supplies will be provided. IPP's are not included in the cost of the workshops.

COST

Cost of workshops are from \$7.50 - \$10.00 per girl.
Deposit of \$30.00 required.
(The standard mileage rate will be charged for over 30 miles not to exceed \$10.00)
NO minimum or maximum size – all size groups accepted!

CADETTES & SENIORS

Advanced Pottery

Option 1: This workshop is for those girls who have completed the Ceramics & Clay badge and want to learn more about pottery. In this workshop we will work on combining techniques: pinch with coil, slab with pinch or coil. We will also work with decorative glazes and the use of underglazes on pre-fired objects. *This is a handbuilding pottery workshop and part of the mobile lessons.*

Option 2: This workshop is for those girls who have completed the Ceramics & Clay badge or have some clay experience in school. In this class we will be working on a potter's wheel and working with decorative glazes and underglazes on pre-fired pieces. ***This class is NOT a mobile lesson. It is open to a maximum number of six girls at one time.*** A portion of the time each girl will work on the wheel and a portion of the time working with the glazes. The workshop will be held at my home in Superior Township just outside of Canton.

Advanced Jewelry Older Girls

This workshop goes beyond the basics- girls will learn to use head pins, findings and other jeweler tools. It is designed to go beyond the basics of stringing beads. We will also explore the use of resin in jewelry making. Girls will make a washer necklace, simple earrings (substitution available), a simple bracelet, and a Makin' clay charm. Project sheets will be available for projects that are not completed in the class.
